It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Title 45 of the General Laws entitled "TOWNS AND CITIES" is hereb

- 3 CHAPTER 69 4 COASTAL HAZARDS 5 45-69-1. Coastal hazards. 6 For the purposes of coastal hazards, including sea level rise and coastal flooding, the state's 7 twenty-one (21) coastal communities are authorized to adopt the coastal resources management 8 council's (CRMC) coastal hazard application process applicable to a local overlay district bounded 9 by the seven foot (7') sea level rise, plus one hundred (100) year recurrence coastal storm as specified by the CRMC's shoreline change special area management plan. This local overlay district 10 shall be for the purposes of assessing coastal hazard risk of structures by applicants seeking local 11
- 12 <u>building permits.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
