## RELATING TO LABOR AND LABOR RELATIONS -- PERMANENT REPLACEMENT EMPLOYEES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 28-10 of the General Laws entitled "Labor Disputes" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

28-10-3.1. Prohibition against the permanent replacement of striking employees.

4 (a) No employer shall grant or offer to grant the status of permanent replacement employee 5 to a person performing bargaining unit work for an employer during a strike of employees in a labor

to a person performing bargaining unit work for an employer during a strike of employees in a labor
 organization, authorized by a representative of employees or after the end of the strike.

7 (b) No employer shall grant or offer to grant the status of permanent replacement employee

8 to a person for engaging or participating in a secondary strike or other protest activities in solidarity

9 with other striking workers.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
