He graduated from Cumberland High School, received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Assumption College, and holds a Master of 8 9 Public Administration degree from the Harvard Kennedy School; and 10 WHEREAS, Governor McKee has had a long and successful business career, serving as 11 an officer of McKee Brothers, an air conditioning, heating, and oil delivery business, and ran a 12 health and fitness business for more than thirty years; and 13 WHEREAS, In his time as the Mayor of Cumberland, Governor McKee successfully 14 collaborated with federal and state officials to minimize the damage from the historic flooding 15 that hit Cumberland and other parts of Rhode Island in 2010. As Lieutenant Governor, he served as the Chair of the National Lieutenant Governors Association, Co-Chair of the NLGA's Energy 16 17 Committee, and as a member of its Education Committee; and 18 WHEREAS, Governor McKee has focused much of his energies as an elected official on

growing the economy and creating an environment and climate in which small businesses can
