- 2 on Naming All New Buildings, Bridges, Edifices and Other State Constructions" is hereby
- 3 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 4 <u>22-7.4-144. Larry Mouradjian fishing pier.</u>
- 5 The fishing pier at Rocky Point state park in Warwick shall hereafter be named and known
- 6 as the "Larry Mouradjian fishing pier."
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
