EXPRESSING CONDOLENCES TO THE WRIGHT FAMILY OF MINNESOTA ON THE PASSING OF DAUNTE WRIGHT

1 WHEREAS, Daunte Wright, a twenty-year old African-American from Minnesota died tragically on April 11, 2021, when he was fatally shot after being stopped for a traffic violation. A 2 3 struggle had ensued between Mr. Wright and police officers, during which one of the police 4 officers, who stated that she thought she had a taser in her hand, instead fired her weapon, resulting in the death of Mr. Wright; and 5 WHEREAS, This tragedy needs to be thoroughly and openly investigated and justice 6 7 must be the end-result for all parties involved. Daunte Wright's mother, Ms. Katie Wright, has properly called for justice for her son and people of color and has also admirably stated that more 8 9 violence in response to this tragedy is not what is needed at this moment in time for the greater 10 Minneapolis community; now, therefore be it 11 RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island hereby 12 expresses its deepest condolences on the untimely and tragic passing of Daunte Wright; and be it 13 further RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and hereby is authorized and directed to 14 15 transmit a duly certified copy of this resolution to Ms. Katie Wright.
