1 WHEREAS, Elizabeth A. "Beth" Vorro, of Bristol, Rhode Island, has been an attorney
2 with the National Labor Relations Board for thirty years, serving as the Rhode Island Resident
3 Agent; and

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Vorro has personified the Labor Board's mission to safeguard
5 employees' rights to organize and bargain collectively, and to be free from unfair labor practices;

7 WHEREAS, Ms. Vorro has also been directly involved in many of Rhode Island's most
8 significant labor disputes as both a skillful attorney and as a voice of reason and compromise; and

9 WHEREAS, In addition to her professional obligations, Ms. Vorro has been a volunteer,
10 mentor, advocate, and leader in the battle for gender equality and LGBTQ+ rights; and

11 WHEREAS, After thirty years as a fighter for justice, Ms. Vorro has decided to retire
12 from the Labor Board and continue her work on behalf of our community as a private citizen;
13 now, therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That this House of Representatives of the State of Rhode Island hereby
15 thanks and congratulates Elizabeth Vorro for her many years of service to the labor community
16 and her Rhode Island neighbors, and extends its best wishes for a well-earned retirement; and be
17 it further

18 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State be and hereby is authorized and directed to

1 transmit a duly certified copy of this resolution to Ms. Elizabeth Vorro.
