It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-25 of the General Laws entitled "Pesticide Control" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 23-25-26.1. Pesticide consumer protection.

- 4 In order to protect consumers from pesticides, any person, business or establishment that
- 5 provides or sells pesticides for home use shall post, in a prominent place where pesticides are
- 6 displayed, the pesticide consumer protection warning or notice produced by the department of
- 7 <u>environmental management.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on February 1, 2023.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- PESTICIDE CONTROL

1 This act would require any person, business or establishment that provides or sells 2 pesticides for home use to post the pesticide consumer protection warning or notice produced by 3 the department of environmental management in a prominent place to protect consumers.
