It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 34-18 of the General Laws entitled "Residential Landlord and Tenant
- 2 Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>34-18-58. Fair limitation on rental application fees.</u>

- 4 <u>A landlord, lessor, sub-lessor, real estate broker, property management company, or</u>
- 5 designee shall not be allowed to require or demand any prospective tenant to pay a rental application
- 6 <u>fee greater than thirty dollars (\$30.00).</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

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RELATING TO PROPERTY – RESIDENTIAL LANDLORD AND TENANT ACT

1 This act would limit the amount a landlord, lessor, sub-lessor, real estate broker, property 2 management company, or designee can require or receive for a rental application fee to thirty 3 dollars (\$30.00).

This act would take effect upon passage.

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
