He was born in Providence, the son of 5 6 Gary Gordon Miller and Joan Jones; and 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller was a Lieutenant with the Coventry Police Department and served the citizens of Coventry and our State with distinction and tireless devotion for twenty-8 three years. He was described by the Department and all of his colleagues and superiors as being 9 10 "the epitome of a great cop, family man and friend." He also liked spending time at Roy Carpenter's Beach with family and friends.
