- SECTION 1. Chapter 46-23 of the General Laws entitled "Coastal Resources Management
  Council" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **46-23-20.7. Staff attorney.**
- 4 The executive director of the coastal resources management council shall have at least one
- 5 <u>full-time</u> attorney-at-law on staff. The attorney-at-law shall represent the executive director and
- 6 staff at council hearings and routine agency matters. The attorney representing the executive
- 7 <u>director and staff shall not represent the council at hearings.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
