10	Corps. Throughout his lifetime, he continued his devotion to his fellow veterans as a founding

14	most of his career in the field of education, serving for many years as the Athletic Director at
15	South Kingstown High School before retiring; and
16	WHEREAS, During his years in high school, college, and later as Athletic Director, Mr.
17	Brown's outstanding athletic talents and his ability to lead, coach, and inspire young athletes,
18	earned him induction into the Hall of Fame at North Kingstown High School, South Kingstown
19	High School, and the University of Rhode Island; and
20	WHEREAS, In addition to his family, veterans' associations, and career, Mr. Brown was

1	a member of the East Coast Drill Instructors Association and the National Association of Watch
2	and Clock Collectors; and
