AMENDING THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE YEARS 2021 AND 2022

1 RESOLVED, That section (45)(d) of the rules for the House of Representatives adopted 2 by the House of Representatives at its January session A.D. 2021 entitled "House Resolution 3 Adopting the Rules of the House of Representatives for the years 2021 and 2022", be and the 4 same is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 (d) Notwithstanding 45(c):

6 (1) Any Caucus organized around a political party affiliation is limited solely to those 7 House members who belong to said party, provided that any member elected to the House as an 8 Independent may caucus with any party, but not more than one party, and not before submitting 9 written communication to the House announcing such intention. The party for which the 10 Independent member wishes to caucus with shall not be obligated to accept the Independent into the caucus, and if permission is so denied, shall communicate that decision to the House clerk 11 12 within seven (7) days of the Independent member's notification to the House. The Speaker shall 13 make such determination for the majority party caucus, and the Minority Leader shall make such 14 decision for the minority party caucus. The Independent then may seek admission to any other 15 party for purposes of joining a caucus.

16 (2) Any Caucus organized around a county and/or municipal affiliation is limited solely17 to those House members who represent said county and or municipality.
