10	endeavors. For many years she volunteered in support of numerous Bristol-Warren Regional
11	School District functions, including serving on the PTA, as a teacher's aide and participating in a
12	plethora of school programs and clubs. She also organized the Cancer Pillow Project at
13	Kickemuit Middle School, where pillows were sewn for students to decorate for chemotherapy
14	patients; and
15	WHEREAS, Ms. Fortin's community service activities also included serving meals to
16	veterans each Thanksgiving and supporting countless local fundraisers and charities. Ms. Forting
17	was a true patriot who proudly displayed her support of our nation and military members,
18	especially her sons Jarret and Jevin; and
19	WHEREAS, A devoted mother who always put family first in her life, Ms. Fortin was
20	also a dedicated Christian who was actively involved in her parish, where she sang in the St.
