SECTION 1. Chapter 16-22 of the General Laws entitled "Curriculum [See Title 16 Chapter 97 — the Rhode Island Board of Education Act]" is hereby amended by adding thereto the

16-22-39. Compulsory nutrition, food preparation and cooking courses.

5 All public high schools in Rhode Island shall require all students to enroll in a nutrition

6 course, food preparation course and cooking course during any year of their four (4) year student
