Regulation of sales tax credits. The attorney general's office shall regulate the sale of tax credits and shall adopt rules and 6 regulations for the supervision of the sale of tax credits by brokers or salespersons as well as 7 establish qualifications for persons and entities certified to act as brokers or salespersons of the tax 8 9 credits. 10 42-165-2. List of authorized brokers and salespersons. 11 The attorney general's office shall maintain an official certified list of all persons 12 authorized to act as brokers and salespersons of the tax credits. 13 42-165-3. Use of authorized brokers or salespersons. 14 No person may hire a broker or salesperson of their choice to aid in the sale of their tax credits. Sellers shall use brokers or salespersons, on a fair and rotating basis, from the attorney 15
