It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 16-2 of the General Laws entitled "School Committees and
- 2 Superintendents [See Title 16 Chapter 97 The Rhode Island Board of Education Act]" is hereby
- 3 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 4 <u>16-2-9.7. Infringement of parental rights.</u>
- 5 (a) The state, any of its political subdivisions, any other governmental entity, or any other
- 6 institution may not infringe on the fundamental rights of a parent to direct the upbringing,
- 7 education, health care, and mental health of his or her minor child without demonstrating that such
- 8 action is reasonable and necessary to achieve a compelling state interest and that such action is
- 9 <u>narrowly tailored and is not otherwise served by a less restrictive means.</u>
- 10 (b) For purposes of this section, the term "parent" means a person who has legal custody
- of a minor child as a natural or adoptive parent or a legal guardian.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
