It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 27-38.2 of the General Laws entitled "Insurance Coverage for Mental
- 2 Illness and Substance Abuse" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 27-38.2-7. Reimbursement from private insurers.
- Every individual or group health insurance contract, plan, or policy delivered, issued, or 4
- 5 renewed by an insurer, health maintenance organization, nonprofit or for-profit health service
- corporation on or after January 1, 2024, that provides benefits to individual subscribers and 6
- members within the state, or to all group members having a principal place of employment within 7
- the state, shall reimburse child care service providers for therapy services offered through EOHHS 8
- 9 certified Kids Connect/Therapeutic Childcare Services.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 10
