It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 36-4 of the General Laws entitled "Merit System" is hereby amended
 by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 36-4-18.1. Temporary exemption from competitive tests.
- 4 (a) Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary to include,
- 5 <u>but not be limited to, § 36-4-18, all job applicants applying for a classified service competitive</u>
- 6 position within the department of human services shall be exempt from completing any competitive
- 7 <u>test for employment.</u>
- 8 (b) The exemption from testing shall apply until July 1, 2024.
- 9 (c) The provisions of this section shall sunset and expire on July 1, 2024
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
