It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-18.9 of the General Laws entitled "Refuse Disposal" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>23-18.9-19. Refuse disposal hours of operation.</u>

- 4 (a) All persons engaged in the business of collection or hauling of refuse shall not empty
- 5 large trash receptacles, commonly known as "dumpsters", within one hundred feet (100') of a
- 6 dwelling unit, as defined § 45-24-31, between the hours of ten o'clock (10:00) pm and eight o'clock
- 7 <u>(8:00) am.</u>
- 8 (b) Subsection (a) of this section shall apply to any person engaged in the business of
- 9 collection or hauling of refuse operating in a non-residential area.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

A N A C T

RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY -- REFUSE DISPOSAL

1 This act would provide time limitations on the collection or hauling of from large trash 2 receptacles (dumpsters) refuse within one hundred feet (100') of a dwelling unit between the hours 3 of ten o'clock (10:00) pm and eight o'clock (8:00) am.

4 This act would take effect upon passage.
