earned his Bachelor's degree in accounting from Providence College followed by his Juris Doctor
from Suffolk University Law School. He is the husband of Deirdre McCaffrey and the father of
Michael, Cailin, Brenna, and Dierdre; and

WHEREAS, Senator McCaffrey's astute legal erudition earned him the Chair of Senate
Judiciary from 2003 until 2017, at which time he was elected by his fellow Senators to the
position of Majority Leader on March 23, 2017; and

WHEREAS, As the Senate Majority Leader, the Honorable Michael McCaffrey is an Ex Officio Member of all standing committees of the Senate. In addition, he has championed numerous initiatives and legislation including enacting court reform measures, diversifying the judiciary, and most recently, propelling the most progressive cannabis regulation system in the country through the legislative process to final enactment; and

Senator McCaffrey is a successful practicing attorney. He maintains a private legal practice in
 Warwick with his brother, James, and is a member of the Rhode Island Bar Association. He also
