It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 11-42 of the General Laws entitled "Threats and Extortion" is hereby 1
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 11-42-4.1. Menacing. 3
- 4 Whoever knowingly and willfully delivers or conveys, directly or indirectly, a verbal,
- 5 written or physical threat to take the life of, or to inflict bodily harm upon, another person, shall be
- guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be imprisoned for not more than one year or fined not more than 6
- 7 one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or both.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES -- THREATS AND EXTORTION

This act would establish the criminal offense of menacing as a misdemeanor and punishable by a year in person or fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

This act would take effect upon passage.
