1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-27.3 of the General Laws entitled "State Building Code" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

- 4 No provision of the Rhode Island building code, or any other law, regulation, or other requirement in Rhode Island, may prohibit or otherwise limit the use of a refrigerant designated as 5 acceptable for use pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of 42 U.S.C. 7671k; provided 6 7 any equipment containing such refrigerant is listed and installed in accordance with safety standards
- and use conditions imposed pursuant to such designation. 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
