No interpreter/transliterator translator appointed pursuant to this chapter to interpret or

translate for limited-English-proficient persons in proceedings before the state courts in Rhode

7 Island shall be called upon to testify concerning any statement(s) and/or confidential

8 <u>communications</u> made to them in connection with the interpreter's or transliterator's any

9 interpretation or translateration translation, properly entrusted to the translator in their professional

10 <u>capacity</u>, without the consent of the person making the statement or unless compelled by court
