# A N ACT <br> RELATING TO COURTS AND CIVIL PROCEDURE--COURTS -- LANGUAGE INTERPRETERS--USE OF LANGUAGE INTERPRETERS IN LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 8-19-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 8-19 entitled "Language Interpreters — Use of Language Interpreters in Legal Proceedings" is hereby amended to read as follows:

8-19-7. Confidential communications.

No interpreter/transliterator translator appointed pursuant to this chapter to interpret or translate for limited-English-proficient persons in proceedings before the state courts in Rhode Island shall be called upon to testify concerning any statement(s) and/or confidential communications made to them in connection with the interpreter's or transliterator's any interpretation or transliteration translation, properly entrusted to the translator in their professional capacity, without the consent of the person making the statement or unless compelled by court order.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
