It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-14-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-14 entitled "False
- 2 Personation" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 11-14-1. Impersonation of public officer.
- 4 Every person who shall falsely assume or pretend to be a judge, justice of the peace,
- 5 warden, deputy sheriff, alderman, member of any city or town council, city or town clerk, state
- court clerk, city sergeant, constable, correctional officer, any other officer of any city or town in 6
- 7 this state as well as any out-of-state police, or the attorney general, deputy attorney general,
- 8 assistant or special assistant attorney general, and shall act as such, shall be imprisoned not
- 9 exceeding one year or be fined not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
