It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-21 of the General Laws entitled "Health and Safety of Pupils" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>16-21-36.1. Parental notification.</u>

- 4 (a) As used in this section, "school" means all public supported schools for students in
- 5 grades kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12) to include, but not limited to, charter schools.
- 6 (b) A school principal shall notify the parents of an unemancipated minor student if the
- 7 <u>student:</u>
- 8 (1) Discloses to an employee or staff member of the school that the student has conflicted
- 9 <u>feelings about or is having difficulty handling or coping with the student's gender identity or gender</u>
- 10 expression; or
- 11 (2) Changes, expresses or indicates a desire to change, or makes a request to change the

12 student's name, attire or pronoun, title, or word to identify the student in a manner that is

- 13 inconsistent with the student's biological sex at birth.
- 14 (c) Not later than five (5) business days after the date on which an employee or staff
- 15 member receives a disclosure or information described in subsection (b) of this section, the
- 16 employee or staff member shall report the disclosure or information to a school principal,
- 17 <u>administrator, or supervisor in a manner prescribed by the school's principal.</u>
- (d) Not later than five (5) business days after the date on which a school principal,
 administrator, or supervisor receives a report described in subsection (c) of this section, the school

- 1 principal shall provide notification to a parent as required by subsection (b).
- 2 (e) Nothing in this chapter may be construed to require a school psychologist, a school
- 3 <u>nurse, a school social worker, or a school counselor to violate any provision of federal or state law.</u>
 - SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION -- HEALTH AND SAFETY OF PUPILS

1	This act would require a public school, including a charter school, to notify the parent of
2	an unemancipated minor, if the student: (1) Makes a certain disclosure concerning the student's
3	gender identity or gender expression to an employee or staff member of the school; or (2) Changes,
4	expresses a desire to change, or makes a request to change the student's name, attire, or pronoun,
5	title, or word to identify the student, in a manner that is inconsistent with the student's biological
6	sex at birth. The act would also require an employee or staff member of a school to report the
7	disclosure or information.

This act would take effect upon passage.
