It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 23-17.7.1-15 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-17.7.1 entitled
- 2 "Licensing of Nursing Service Agencies" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 23-17.7.1-15. Nursing service agencies exempt.
- 4 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to:
- 5 (1) Nursing service agencies and nursing exempt from regulation by the state; <u>or</u>
- 6 (2) Visiting nursing services or home health services conducted by and for those who rely
- 7 exclusively upon spiritual means through prayer alone in accordance with the creed or tenets of a
- 8 recognized church or religious denomination<del>; or</del>
- 9 (3) Nursing service agencies who limit the provision of temporary staff, including
- 10 registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, or nursing assistants, to one or more hospitals provided
- 11 that such nursing service agency maintain certification from the joint commission on the
- 12 accreditation of health care organizations or such other accreditation entity acceptable to the
- 13 director.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
