It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 31-10.3 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Uniform

Commercial Driver's License Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

31-10.3-13.1. Education and training to recognize and report human trafficking.

4 Any trade school or education program offering instruction in the operation of commercial

5 motor vehicles for licensure pursuant to this chapter, and any entity employing a certified

6 commercial driving instructor to provide commercial driver training, as defined in this chapter,

7 shall offer and include, as part of the commercial motor vehicle driving course curriculum,

8 industry-specific training on the recognition, prevention, and reporting of human trafficking. The

9 <u>division of motor vehicles administrator, as defined in this chapter, shall be responsible for ensuring</u>

the instruction requirements of this section are met. The administrator, in conjunction with

organizations that specialize in the recognition and prevention of human trafficking, shall annually

12 review and update the training to include changes and trends in human trafficking.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
