RELATING TO PROPERTY -- RESIDENTIAL LANDLORD TENANT ACT

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 34-18-16.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 34-18 entitled
- 2 "Residential Landlord and Tenant Act" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 34-18-16.1. Rent increases Notice requirements.
- 4 (a) Prior to an increase in rent being imposed by a landlord for a residential tenancy, notice
- of the increase shall be given in writing to any tenant by a landlord at least thirty (30) ninety (90)
- 6 days prior to the effective date of the increase.
- 7 (b) A landlord must give sixty (60) one hundred twenty (120) days notice to month to
- 8 month tenants over the age of sixty-two (62), before raising the rent.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
