The number of directors is fixed by, or in the manner provided in, the articles of incorporation or the bylaws ~~except as to the number constituting the initial board of directors, which number is fixed by the articles of incorporation.~~ The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by amendment to, or in the manner provided in, the articles of incorporation or the bylaws, but no decrease has the effect of shortening the term of any incumbent director. If the articles of incorporation provide for the election of directors in the manner specified in subsection (d) of section 7-1.2-708, the number of directors may not be decreased unless approved by the shareholders with less than the number of shares previously entitled to elect one director voting against the decrease. ~~In the absence of a bylaw fixing the number of directors, the number is the same as that provided for in the articles of incorporation. The names and addresses of the members of the first board of directors must be stated in the articles of incorporation. Those persons~~ Initial directors hold office until the first annual meeting of shareholders, and until their successors have been elected and qualified. At the first annual meeting of shareholders and at each subsequent annual meeting, the shareholders shall elect directors to hold office until the next succeeding annual meeting, except in the case of the classification of directors as permitted by this chapter. Each director holds office for the term for which he is elected and until his successor has been elected and qualified. Any director may resign at any time upon notice given in writing to the corporation.

7-1.2-906. Restated articles of incorporation. [Effective July 1, 2005.] -- (a) The corporation may at any time restate its articles of incorporation as previously amended by filing with the secretary of state restated articles of incorporation. The restated articles of incorporation may include one or more amendments to the articles of incorporation adopted in accordance with the provisions of section 7-1.2-~~901~~ 903.

(b) The restated articles of incorporation must state all of the provisions of the articles of incorporation as previously amended, the additional amendments to the articles of incorporation, if any, together with a statement that such additional amendments were adopted in accordance with the provisions of section 7-1.2-903, and a further statement that, except for the designated amendments, if any, the restated articles of incorporation correctly set forth without change the corresponding provisions of the articles of incorporation as previously amended, and that the restated articles of incorporation, together with the designated amendments, if any, supersede the original articles of incorporation and all previous amendments to the articles of incorporation."
