AN ACT RELATING TO FILM AND TELEVISION TAX CREDIT

Mr. Speaker:

I hereby move to amend 2005 -- H 6201 SUBSTITUTE A, entitled "AN ACT RELATING TO FILM AND TELEVISION TAX CREDIT", as follows:

(1) Page 7, by inserting the following language between lines 6 and 7:

"Section 3. Restrictions on members of general assembly. – (a) No member of the general assembly shall participate in any "state certified production" as defined in section 44-31.2-2 as either an individual investor or as a partner or stockholder of an investor, for any reason whatsoever during their service in the general assembly and for a period of five (5) years after the member's last day as a member of the general assembly. For purposes of this section, "member of the general assembly" shall mean any person who served as a member thereof at any time after January 2005.

(b) No member of the general assembly shall accept any compensation as a result of their participation in or affiliation with any "state certified production" for any reason whatsoever during their service in the general assembly and for a period of five (5) years after the member's last day as a member of the general assembly. For purposes of this section, "member of the general assembly" shall mean any person who served as a member thereof at any time after January 2005.

(c) Violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) not more than five (5) years in jail.

(d) The provisions of subsection (a) hereof shall be deemed to be in addition to the requirements imposed upon members of the general assembly by the ethics law of this state, and the rules and regulations of the ethics commission."

(2) Page 7, line 7, by deleting the number "3" and inserting in place thereof the number "4".
